

Saturday, august 20, 2016 at 2pm

#### Tournament

- Echecs-Club Bois-Gentil, 58, Cité Villars, 1203 Genève
- 4-fold round robin (depending of the number of participants), with a final match between the two first teams. Eventual ties will be decided by a qualification match.
- Time control : 3 minutes.
- Free subscription, limited to 20 teams.
- Teams can be arranged on the spot.

- Drop check and drop mate are allowed.
- Pawns get promoted.
- ◆ Touch-move !
- noisily-communicating players are accepted
